AFFILIATED LEAGUES' COUNCIL GUIDELINES

INTRODUCED JUNE 1991

SECTION ONE: MISSION STATEMENT

Through the involvement of local administrators, the Affiliated Leagues' Council will enhance the New South Wales Australian Football League's management of Australian Football within the State Boundary so that it will develop as a reputable and competitive member of the National structure.

SECTION TWO: OBJECTIVES

- 2.1 The Affiliated Leagues' Council shall investigate and report to the N.S.W.A.F.L. Commission on all matters relating to, and affecting, Australian Football outside the Metropolitan area of Sydney. Such matters may include the following:-
- 2.1.1. Specific aspects requiring development initiatives.
 - 2.1.2. The deployment of Development Staff.
 - 2.1.3. Allocation of Junior Development funds or projects.
 - 2.1.4. Composition of constituent competitions.
 - 2.1.5. All other issues of concern.
- 2.2 The Affiliated Leagues' Council through its constituent Regional Boards shall implement any proposal and plans as the Commission shall, from time to time, approve.
- 2.3 The Affiliated Leagues' Council, and its constituent Regional Boards, will, at all times, operate as a Committee of the New South Wales Australian Football League, and as such, be governed by the conditions set out in articles 65 and 66 of the N.S.W.A.F.L.'s Memorandum and Articles of Association.
- 2.4 The Chairman of the Affiliated Leagues' Council will be appointed from among the N.S.W.A.F.L. Commissioners.

SECTION THREE: REGIONAL BOARDS

3.1 Structure

- 3.1.1. Six Regional Boards will be established and membership thereof will be available to the following Australian Football Leagues and Associations, provided the required affiliation fees and commitments have been met:
